PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

STRONGCRETE 15 Minute is perfect for setting posts fast! – just add water and you're good to go! Great for jobs like fences, clotheslines, and mailbox-es—just concrete the post in, 15 minute set time and 1 hour cure time allows you to get on with the rest of the job.

Not for structural work—for that, use **STRONGCRETE Ready-to-Use** or **STRONGCRETE 45MPa**.

Doing corner posts? Go for **STRONGCRETE Hi-Strength 15 Minute** for extra hold.

QUANTITIES

Please refer to our website www.strongcrete.co.nz for our concrete calculator.

As a guide: for posts 1.8m in length, 2 bags of **STRONGCRETE 15 Minute** are required. 1.9 - 3L of water are required per bag.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARATION

- Thoroughly wet the hole to compensate for any ground drainage which may absorb water required to set the **STRONGCRETE 15 Minute Concrete**.
- Position and place the post in the hole.

APPLICATION

- Add water to the hole 1.9-3L per bag of **STRONGCRETE 15 Minute** begin use.
- Immediately pour the bag of **STRONGCRETE 15 Minute** into the hole evenly around the post - do not mix.
- Check the post position and add extra water to any visibly dry spots. Level immediately if necessary.

NOTES

- If using multiple bags - repeat steps above - layers may be separated by a layer of compacted earth.

HANDY TIPS

- In sandy soil we recommend lining the hole with plastic to slow water loss.
- After a minimum of 15 mins the concrete can be topped with compacted earth and the structure can be drilled or nailed.
- Leave for 1 hour before using the post under more substantial pressure such as wire straining

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store locked up. Keep dry and store off the ground. 12 months when stored in original unopened packaging.
