STRONGCRETE Ready-to-Use Concrete – just add water and you're good to go! It's a quality mix of river-run sand, cement, and special ingredients that makes it super easy to use and sets strong. Great for all those concrete jobs around the house and garden – big or small.

QUANTITIES

The addition of 1.4 - 2L of water to 20kg will produce 9.5 - 10L of concrete.

CONCRETE MIXER



Using a Concrete Mixer? Here's how:

- Start by adding most of the 1.4–2 litres of water (per 20kg bag) into the mixer and switch it on.
- Slowly pour in the **STRONGCRETE Ready-to-Use Concrete** while it's spinning.
- If the mix feels a bit dry, add the rest of the water—only if needed.

HAND MIXING



Mixing by Hand? No worries:

- Tip the **STRONGCRETE Ready-to-Use Concrete** into a wheelbarrow, bucket, or clean flat surface. You'll need about 1.4–2 litres of clean water per 20kg bag.
- Add the water a bit at a time, mixing well with a spade (or whatever you've got) after each splash.
- Stop when the mix is smooth and workable—don't overdo the water, just enough to make it easy to place and finish.

HANDY TIPS

- Avoid excess water as this will impact durability and strength.
- Mix it up well until it's all one even colour and texture.
- Pour it carefully and give it a good pat down to get rid of any air pockets.
- Smooth it out how you like – but don't overdo it with the trowel.
- Keep it damp for at least 7 days so it sets strong and lasts longer.
- Protect the concrete by keeping it continually moist for at least 7 days.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store locked up. Keep dry and store off the ground. 12 months when stored in original unopened packaging.
